- Mono-material solutions, like full PE films that are designed for recyclability*
- Solutions that can help enable the incorporation of recycled content with ExxonMobil performance polymers which can help to maintain/boost performance
- Downgauged solutions that can reduce material usage, allowing converters to do more with less

These advanced solutions, which incorporate ExxonMobil's performance polymers that can help boost performance while enabling sustainability benefits, include:

- "Designed for recyclability*" packaging solutions including full polyethylene (PE) lamination films, lap seal/fin seal pouches; PE rich barrier packaging films; and agricultural solutions including mulch and greenhouse films; and high gloss impact copolymer polypropylene (ICP) solutions replacing ABS in appliance.
- Packaging structures, including collation shrink films, that can help enable the incorporation of recycled content.
- Applications that can do more with less including: downgauged greenhouse films, pond liners, laminated films, and heavy duty sacks for agricultural and industrial products.
- Value-added rotational molded rigid packaging solutions.

"Plastex provides a unique opportunity for ExxonMobil to display and explain to visitors how our full portfolio of solutions can help to address, costeffectively, the increasing sustainability challenges faced by industry today," said Hari Gusain, Market Development Manager Middle East and Africa, ExxonMobil. - Vistamaxx[™] performance polymers and Exact[™] polyolefin elastomers to boost performance, like impact strength, which can help enable innovative possibilities for applications incorporating increased levels of recycled PP and PE content.
- ExxonMobil[™] PP and Achieve[™] Advanced PP for applications requiring impact strength and stiffness such as injection molded or extrusion molded automotive components, appliance parts and rigid packaging.
